
And from Geoff, G0DDX

Robert, Please see attached File for my December Fists Ladder session. Not many stations worked, again.



On the Antenna front, I have constructed a Magnetic loop over the last few weeks. I made the butterfly Capacitor, and got it working for the 11th Nov Ladder.

A friend cut the Capacitor plates for me with a Water Jet using 60,000 PSI of pressure! It covers 14 thru to 30Mhz with SWR of better then 1:1.5 on all bands.



I worked Erkki on 20m, and got 589 on my Long Wire, and then changed to the loop. He then gave me 579. Which I thought was very good, considering the loop was hanging from the ceiling fan inside the shack!!



I have since motorised the capacitor, and now just need to box it up, weatherproof it, then relocate outside.

Next job is a larger loop to cover 160-30m, and I recon that will be about

Ametre Diameter. A bit on the large side!
It was nice to get on air on Xmas day. Not many stations about, I suspect many amateurs were too full of Xmas Pud!

I'm looking forward to 2012 as I can start the Ladder at the beginning of the year. Probably on the bottom rung!
